#### AUTONOMOUS VEHICLE SHUTTLE PILOT-PHASE 2

This pilot project will operate for 12 months at a site located in Salt Lake City. The autonomous electric shuttle will be fully integrated into the UTA transit network and will have a standard operating schedule, a UTA route number, and will be included in the public schedule along with integrated trip finding features. UTA is invested in understanding how emerging technologies and new mobility solutions can meet future objectives such as electric, emission-free transit and travel needs of individuals by enhancing community accessibility through safe, reliable and innovative services. Autonomous and connected technologies have high potential to be a solution for public transit. This pilot project provides the opportunity for UTA to learn more about future mobility possibilities.



## ADVANCING URBAN EFFICIENCY TO IMPROVE UTAH'S AIR QUALITY

The Utah Clean Energy program will offer tools, in-depth trainings and support across four to six jurisdictions along the Wasatch Front, particularly those experiencing high levels of projected growth. They will include half- to full-day trainings on urban efficiency topics, including zero to low emission construction, energy code enforcement and electric vehicle planning. The trainings will be structured with multiple sessions, each designed to reach a variety of city representatives. Utah Clean Energy will also consult with the homebuilding industry to gain feedback on how local governments can better collaborate with homebuilders who are interested in pursuing zero to low emission construction.

## PARTNERSHIPS

#### GAS CAN EXCHANGE

UCAIR worked with Union Pacific, Boeing and the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation to administer a gas can exchange. UCAIR launched the program on April 13, 2019 at Boeing, where Utahns gathered from across the state to replace their old gas cans with new EPA-compliant gas cans to further reduce emissions and promote cleaner, healthier air. UCAIR and its partners exchanged 1,000 gas cans, which is estimated to eliminate the equivalent emissions of 108 cars per day.

#### LIME HERO

UCAIR became the exclusive beneficiary of the Lime Hero donation program in Utah. Lime Hero gives scooter riders the option to round up the cost or add a small percentage to the cost of their ride to be donated to a local nonprofit.

#### CLEAR THE AIR CHALLENGE

In partnership with the Salt Lake Chamber and TravelWise, UCAIR supports the 2020 Clear the Air Challenge, which runs during the month of February. Additionally, funds will support the Clean Air Champions program, which is a year-round initiative that encourages employers and employees to implement clean air strategies.
